Interesting quote from Mr. John Clifton, CEO of Gallup.

Mr. Clifton was asked this question? How do you get something like job growth started? Does it start at the national level?

Mr. Clifton responded, "No. The way you fix America, or any country, is at the city level. Thriving cities are essential to a country's success, and there's no way you can fix your cities without positive momentum among small organizations, as well as among 5<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> graders. 


