Introduction

As part of the State Regents' cooperative effort with the State Department of Education to provide measures or "indicators" of educational performance, the High School Indicators Project has produced the Headcount, Semester Hours, and GPA Report. This report provides one method of assessing the educational performance of first-time-entering freshmen that go directly to college. It is an indicator of the adequacy of the educational preparation of the previous year high school graduates.

Methodology

The data used to construct this report have been categorized in cooperation with the State Department of Education by county, district, and high school site. This report provides academic year headcount, semester hour, and cumulative GPA information on 17-, 18-, and 19-year-old first-time-entering freshmen. For each county, district, and high school site the total headcount, semester hours, headcount number and percent by GPA (0.0-1.6, 1.7-1.9, 2.0-2.9, 3.0+), and semester hours number and percent by GPA are provided by each individual public institution of higher education and higher education tier.

These first-time-entering freshmen are the same students identified in the linear-rate in the most recent single-year section of the "High School to College-Going Rates of Oklahoma High School Graduates" report. The total number of first-time-entering freshmen will differ on these two reports because the "High School to College-Going Rates of Oklahoma High School Graduates" report accounts for both public and private institutions of higher education and this report accounts for only the public institutions.

For public institutions of higher education with five or fewer students, the headcount and total semester hours have been entered but no additional GPA information has been provided in order to comply with the federal Privacy Act. An asterisk has been entered next to the headcount reported as a reminder that this situation exists. If the headcount for tier totals (comprehensive, four-year, two-year, and total) is greater than five, the GPA data for headcount and semester hours are provided.

Due to the detailed information provided for each high school site, district, and county in Oklahoma, the report is over a thousand pages long. Consequently, the summary by site/county has been selected for your review as an attachment.
